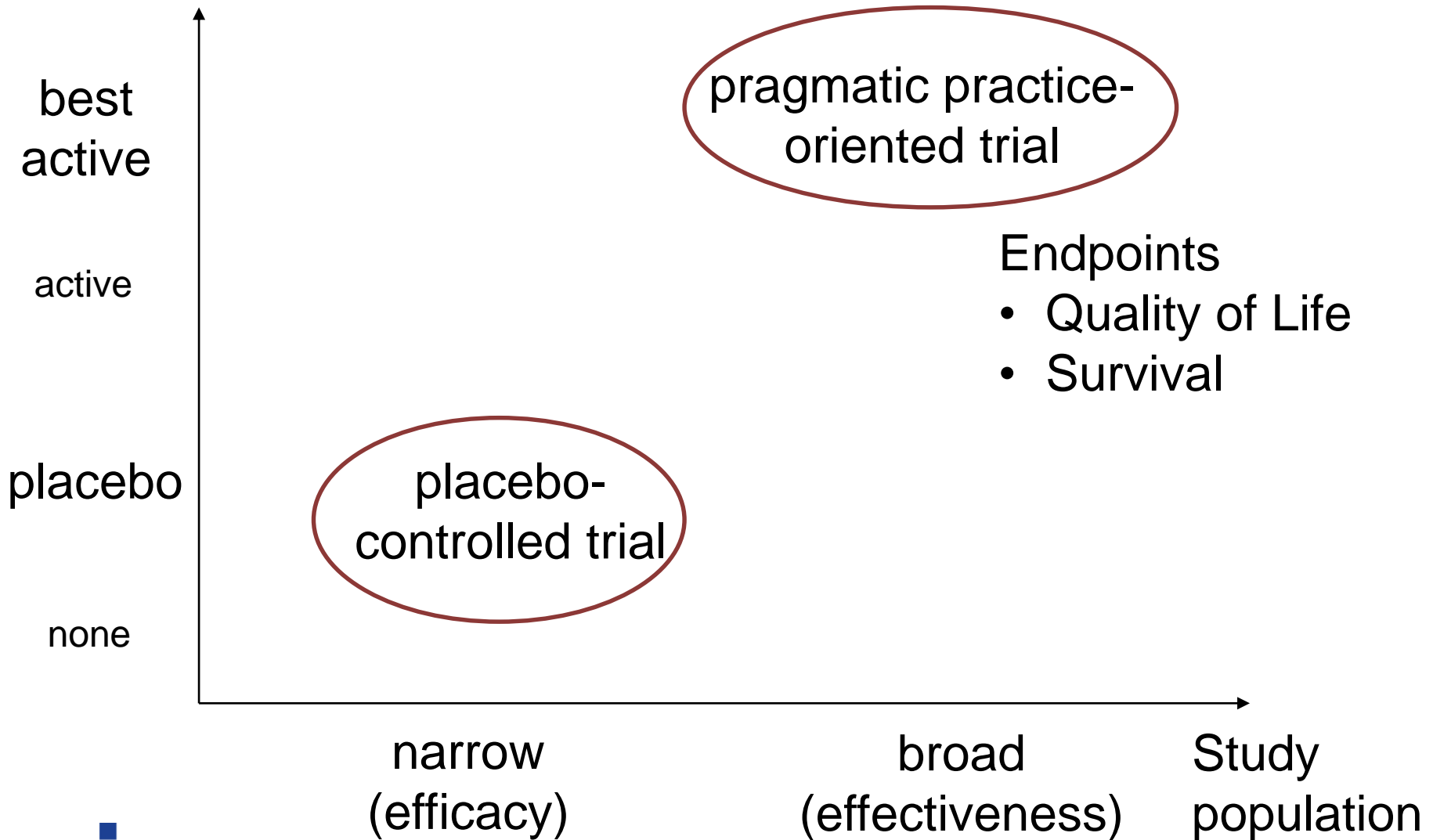

The healthcare payers

- **Aim to maximise health within the available budget.**
- **HTA desktop research: often no answer, comparative trials missing.**
- **Selecting and funding clinical trials should be part of the R&D of healthcare payers.**
- **The trials should answer questions of relevance for the healthcare payer.**

KCE Trials

- **Immediately useful to patients, clinical practice (effectiveness), and policy or decision makers (efficiency)**
- **Extension of KCE HTA programme as at NIHR**
- **National and international trials**
- **Commissioned and researcher-led**
- **KCE is the funder, not the sponsor**

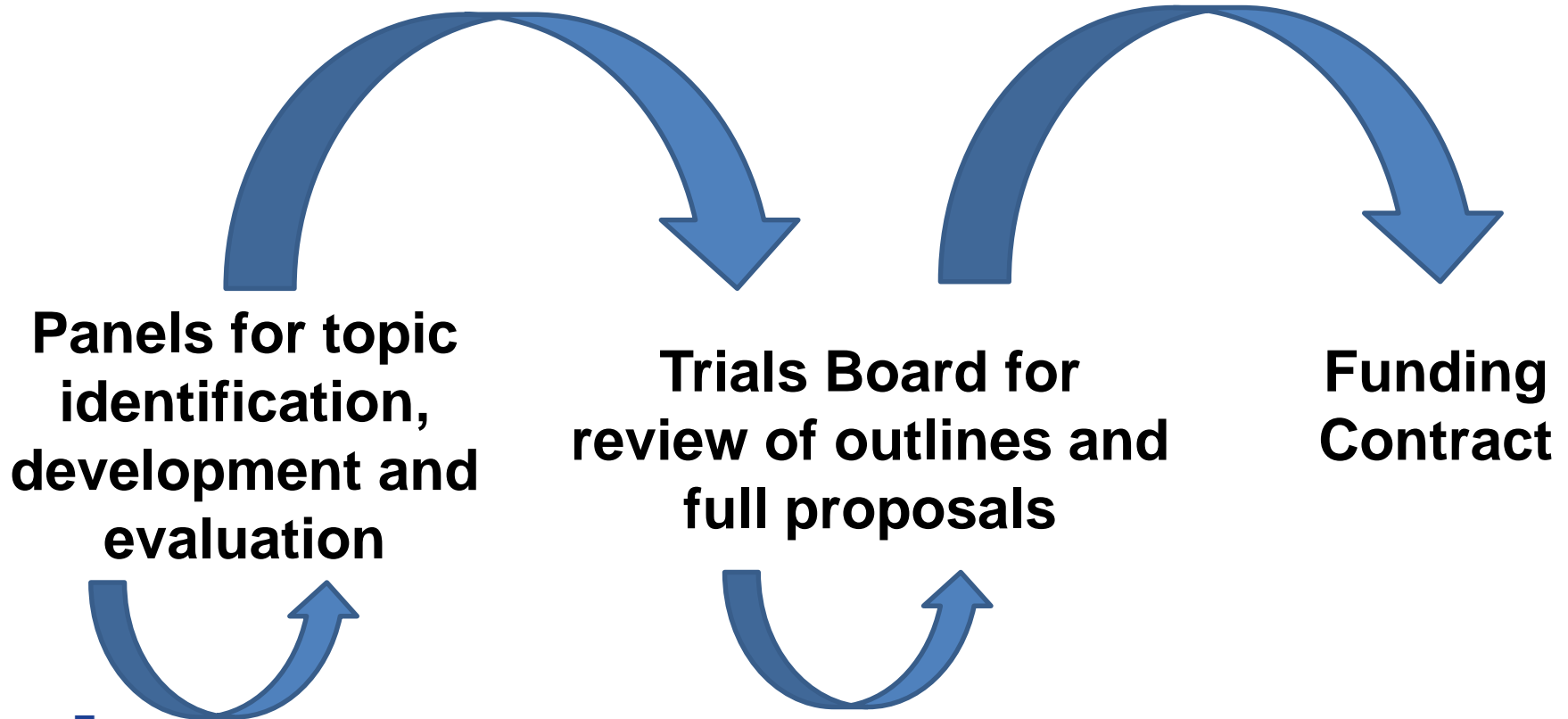

KCE Trials – general criteria

both for topic selection and review of proposals

- **Need for the Evidence**
 - Importance, impact
- **Value for Money**
 - Possible Return on Investment
- **Scientific Rigour**
 - Will answer the question
 - Feasible and deliverable

Specific criteria for 2016 commissioned workstream

- **Comparative effectiveness trial**
- **Randomised**
- **eCRF**
- **Patients available**
- **Max three year period**
- **Low risk of recruitment delay**
- **Implementation after trial is feasible**
